<b>Required skills</b>	<p>This course includes but is not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Duty-of-care, legal limitations and considerations.</li> <li>• Emergency access procedures (inc. calling Ambulance)</li> <li>• Consideration of relevant workplace hazards/issues</li> <li>• Infection control principles and procedures, including use of standard precautions</li> <li>• Privacy and confidentiality requirements</li> <li>• Unconscious Patient &amp; Recovery Position</li> <li>• DRSABCD &amp; CPR including use of defibrillator</li> </ul>
<b>Assessment</b>	Practical assessment using manikins attaching an AED and scenarios. Theory assessment (multiple choice questions)
<b>Participants Requirements</b>	It is a requirement of this course that you are physically capable of performing uninterrupted CPR for at least four minutes on a manikin placed on the floor.
