Required skills	 This course includes but is not limited to: Duty-of-care, legal limitations and considerations. Emergency access procedures (inc. calling Ambulance) Consideration of relevant workplace hazards/issues Infection control principles and procedures, including use of standard precautions Privacy and confidentiality requirements Unconscious Patient & Recovery Position DRSABCD & CPR including use of defibrillator
Assessment	Practical assessment using manikins attaching an AED and scenarios. Theory assessment (multiple choice questions)
Participants Requirements	It is a requirement of this course that you are physically capable of performing uninterrupted CPR for at least four minutes on a manikin placed on the floor.
